### Mobile ID and Mustering Software from SMI Now available on DAP's Rugged Handheld Computers

Cardholders can be accounted for at mustering sites without the handheld computer being connected to the main security system, which could be compromised in a situation like a fire or severe weather event.

"SMI offers a ready-to-go mobile dimension to existing access control systems using our reliable and rugged handheld computers."
